Wyemoore Bridge is Falling Down										

The year is 2023. An investigation of the main suspension cables on the Wyemoore Bridge was carried out to establish the extent of any corrosion. The work has been progressed with the active co-operation of the Wyemoore River Crossing Authority (WRCA). Visual inspection of the condition of the main suspension cables at nine separate locations is now complete. Corrosion has been identified. The participant outlines how they will approach the issues in their presentation.

Wind Farm

A range of local opinions have been gathered by the Storm Islands Council Department of Public Affairs to understand how receptive the local population is to a wind farm proposal. This information has been submitted to the Media Club (a PR company). The participant outlines how they will manage the various stakeholder interests in their presentation, along with the communications and PR issues.

Road Signs

As part of a drive to improve road congestion in the county of Southbarn a Public Private Partnership (PPP) was set up between the Roads Agency and a civil engineering company, Southbarn Civil Engineering (SCE). SCE was tasked with a number of enhancements to the motorway infrastructure that links Southbarn to the major business centres. The focus is on road, signage and bridges. The participant outlines how they will approach the issues in their presentation.

During the twelve months ending May 2021, the Transport Security Intervention Initiative (TSII) security inspectors recorded more than eighty security breaches at the Eurorail ESML, including eight incidents it classified as "failures of security leading to unacceptable or undesirable consequences". The disclosure could not come at a worse time for the government, which is preparing to authorise the controversial construction of a new generation of sonic speed trains later this year. The participant outlines how they will approach these issues in their presentation.

Crime Prevention			

Lechlade Metro Light Railway Station is located East of Holmesborough City Centre, approximately 100 kilometres away from the main high street. Due to poor investment and deteriorating conditions, the Station's criminal activities continue to drastically rise. Railway police are experiencing great difficulty in managing these cases whilst at the same time, dealing with the day-today network policing. The participant outlines how they will apply an Environmental Crime framework to Lechlade in their presentation.

CultureFEST

The Festival of Culture represents an annual city festival celebrating cultural diversity through the performing arts. It brings together a wide range of cultural traditions and art forms from a cross section of the community. Some recent public relations issues have led to the establishment of an Independent Review Board (IRB) to evaluate the operation and funding of the Festival. This board has been commissioned to propose a series of management improvements. The participant (from the IRB) outlines how they will approach the issues in their presentation.

Community				
Regeneration				

The background to the presentation exercise revolves around a city in the South of England (Northwart). The city has a number of social issues. Community regeneration is a key domestic policy issue, which has led to the creation of the Commission for Community Regeneration (CCR). Senior council officials from Northwart City Council have approached the CCR with a view to establishing a working alliance to implement an effective strategy to combat drug use. The participant (from the CCR) outlines how they will approach these issues in their presentation.

Caratna – Woman			
Walk			

The background to the work simulation exercise is set in a fictitious country called Caratna in 2020. A number of international support organisations have highlighted transport as a central factor for economic growth and the alleviation of poverty. As a result, a coalition between leading international transport experts resulted in the formation of the World Agency Tackling Poverty through Transport. The most predominant mode of travel for low-income women in Caratna is walking. Women's access to vehicles and services is actually often more constrained by socio-cultural conventions or even bans rather than by physical barriers. The participant outlines how they will approach the issue of making transport more accessible to woman in their presentation.
